Learn from The Network Guy

One of my televisions has a terrible picture. I don't think it's a problem with my cable, because every other tv in the house seems fine. Are there any simple troubleshooting suggestions that may help?

The Network Guy:

That's a great question! Sometimes the fix is as simple as a new HDMI cable. Since it is responsible for delivering high-definition audio and video signals from a single cord, any degradation from age or breakage can make a big difference to the quality of your sound or picture. If you're experiencing shooting stars or sparkling in your picture that may sound like white noise, a blurry or fuzzy image, no image or imaging dropping, a loss of sound, or poor screen resolution, a new HDMI cable may be the quick fix you need.

Faulty cables can have damage in one of the 19 pins within the connector. They may also have physical damage to the wires or general wear and tear. If you have any extra HDMI cables on hand, try them with your devices first to ensure the problem is with the cable rather than the hardware.
