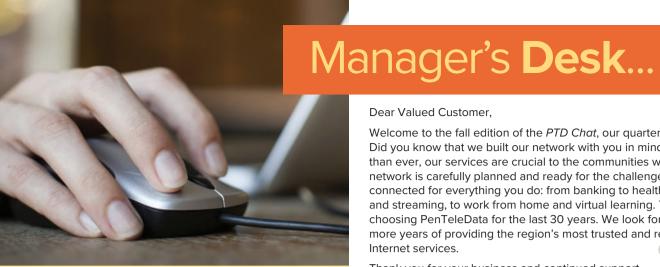


Our customers always comment on the lightning speed of our Internet. PenTeleData's fiber connection helps us provide the best guest experience possible."

## **Fiber Optics:** More Than Just Internet Connectivity

Did you know that the fiber optic cables used for Internet connectivity can also be used as sensors? The Fiber Optic Sensing Association is promoting this dual usage. The fiber optic cables can also act as giant sensors with use cases for public utilities, transportation companies, and smart cities.

Distributed Fiber Optic Sensing (DFOS) uses optical fibers to send pulses of light many times per second. When that occurs, DFOS can measure changes in the backscattering of the light when it encounters an unusual vibration, strain, or temperature changes. It creates a long-distancing passive sensor with high spatial resolution that occurs in real-time. Combined with AI, it is possible to detect and classify location and what is occurring based on libraries of information. This information can monitor things such as vehicle movement, digging activity, the health of bridges and railways, liquid and gas leaks, and many other conditions. Utility providers could be notified of an open manhole. Another example could be traffic alerts, especially since there are already many long-haul and middle-mile networks along interstate highways, so the fiber could be used as distributed traffic sensors.
